



Basketball SA Working With Children Policy Statement

Purpose

To provide a comprehensive guide to member protection procedures for Basketball SA members in all service levels.

Scope

This policy applies to all Basketball SA stadiums (Hillcrest, Port Adelaide, Wayville, Pasadena, Marion and Morphett Vale); regular programs hiring venues under Basketball SA auspices at Titanium Security Arena, STARplex, Mt Barker Recreation Centre, ARC Campbelltown & MARS; and all coaches and administrators involved in the delivery of junior basketball services through Basketball SA (including SA Country Associations).

South Australian legislation requires that all organisations that provide services for children create and maintain child safe environments. All personnel involved in the provision of services to children will be required to obtain a DCSI Working with Children clearance. Basketball SA wishes to provide the best available member protection guidance for those delivering basketball in South Australia.

Policy Statement

It is the policy of Basketball SA that effective October 2018:

- All Basketball SA full time and casual staff have a DCSI Working with Children clearance prior to employment.
- All Basketball SA full time and casual staff attend at least one member protection training session per period covered by the DCSI Working with Children clearance.
- All Basketball SA full time and casual staff attend one mandatory reporting training session per period covered by the DCSI Working with Children clearance.
- All coaches are required to obtain a DCSI Working with Children clearance prior to their first game coached
- All Basketball SA referees have a DCSI Working with Children clearance
- All the prescribed positions above have updated records in Sports TG for the respective requirement listed.
